Pastor Nancy began with Devotions and Prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Herb reported for the Trustee issues. There was a discussion about needing to find someone to fill the Trustee position. Mid-American has flagged the ruts to be fixed. The work will be done by subcontractors. The boiler shut off is supposed to be outside of the boiler room door. Herb will contact Drees about that. The Brotherhood Insurance Company has come in \$500 cheaper than Church Mutual. They are willing to come to speak to the Board about their program if desired. Ann Trimble-Ray moved to have the representative come in October to explain their program. Jan Mason seconded it. Ayes all.

Dennis Steele report for Giving. Herb Padgett reported on the finances. There are no outstanding big bills.

Melanie Hauser spoke to the Board about setting up online giving option for members. Most people under 50 do not carry checks or much cash. She suggested the Bravo Company who charge a fee of 0.25% of the giving. It would be possible to also ad a QR code to the bulletin. Melanie offered also to talk to people about this option at the upcoming Sundaes on Sunday. She suggested we pilot the program here and then expand to the other two churches. Ann Trimble-Ray moved to begin online giving. Dennis Steels seconded and Ayes all.

Anita Mason reported for the Endowment. We have 142 members. There is \$1467 in the Memorial Fund.

Jan Mason reported for Outreach. We are gathering items for Ingathering. Material is available for making the bags. Anyone interested will be meet next Tuesday at 1 to cut out material for the bags and make it available for anyone who wants to sew them together. There are only 3 casseroles left so need to make some more. Several prayer shawls were brought in the Cudaback girls.

Jeannette Weber reported for Christian Education. So far there are only 2 kids for Sunday School so there will be no Waffle Sunday as a kickoff for Sunday school. She is working on a list of possible students. Sunday school will be before Worship at 9am beginning Sept. 11. Coffee Fellowship will be at 9am.

Ann Trimble-Ray reported that Sundaes on Sunday will include a mission project. Reports for charge conference are due next month. Ann shared her experience of a two point charge in the district as they deal with questions of disaffiliation. So much hurt and confusion. So much unknown.

Pastor Nancy has scheduled a joint meeting for the 3 churches including the Chair of the Board, SPRC chair, and Treasurer of each church. Discussion will include Christmas Services, Form I, and times of worship for Silver Creek and Lakes. We will work on Charge Conference forms next month. On August 20th the Redeemed Trio Concert will be Lakes UMC at 7pm. On August 21, worship will be at Prairie Pedlar at 10am with a pot luck following. No worship services here in Early.

Meeting ended with all praying the Lord's Prayer.

Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings

- Psalm 17:8

Some foods are often associated with a month or a season... cookies at Christmas, pumpkins in October, turkey at Thanksgiving, blarney stones in March, watermelon in July and my favorite, apples in September.

September pictures often have apples in them – picking ripe apples from a tree, giving an apple to the teacher, making apple crisp or apple pie, etc. While apples are available all during the year, September seems to be their month. Apples are so versatile. They are found in so many recipes! And they taste so good in so many different ways.

Even though the apple is not specifically mentioned in the Genesis stories, we often associate Eve's sin with eating an apple. That's a pretty bad rap!

God sure turns it around though when he tells us we are the apple of his eye..... So what does that mean?

Apples are loved on many levels by so many people. There is nothing like that first snap of a bite into a crisp apple. There is nothing like the smell of an apple or apples baking. There is nothing like the beautiful red of a polished apple. There are 7,500 varieties of apples in existence throughout the world—2,500 of which are grown in the United States. Apples come in so many shapes and colors and tastes and uses. Just like us!

God created each one of us – so many shapes and colors and talents and gifts. Each one of us unique and that is why God loves us. Each one of us is created in God's own image and likeness and that is why God loves us.



To be the apple of God's eye means that he sees us as we are – created by him in love. No matter what we may have done or become, that is the bottom line. Even if you feel you are at the bottom of the barrel and nothing is right about your life, God loves you. You are the apple of his eye – and NOTHING can or will change that.

God has proven that to us again and again. No matter what we have done, like the prodigal son's father, he comes running down the road to meet us. No matter what we have done, God continues to give us what we need when we need it. We don't always recognize the gift but that does not deny that God is at work in our lives and in our hearts. How can we ignore the greatest gift he has given us when he sent Jesus to us and Jesus laid down his life for each of us. What more can he do to show you that you are the apple of his eye?

If someone is the apple of your eye, a spouse, a child, a grandchild, someone special, you know you will do anything for that person. It's the same with God – there is no limit to his love for you or what he will do for you that is good for you.

When someone is the apple of your eye, you find such joy in that person – same with God! He finds such joy in us – even if we can't see it. We can trust that is much to celebrate in us because God says there is. God's eyes see so much more than our mere human eyes do. Believe what God sees! You ARE the apple of his eye!
